Portugal may be unknown to many, but its region of **Trás-os-Montes** is even more so. An untaped land north of the Douro, sheltered by a chain of mountains ("Trás-os-Montes" in Portuguese means "behind the mountains"), this is a land of ancient **Celtic** roots. A mountainous terroir of mostly **granitic soils**, facing **extreme temperatures** in summer and in winter. There, in the region of Chaves, one hour from Porto, stands the village of **Loivos**, a famed land of fine wines and quality olive oil.
